Online Learning

How to access The Learning Exchange:

To log in to The Learning Exchange, visit bbbs.csod.com. Enter your Username (**your email address**) and the password you set up during your enrollment process. ***If you cannot access your TLE account, please contact your program coordinator for assistance.***

How to access the Race, Relationships, and Resources Playlists once in TLE:

1. From the TLE Welcome Page, in the upper right-hand corner, click the magnifying glass icon.
2. Enter "Race, Relationships, and Resources" and hit "Enter."
3. All **Race, Relationships, and Resources** playlists will display.
4. Click on the name of a playlist you want to access and click the "Follow" button to be updated when new resources are added.
